Come participate in a free program designed for young women interested in energy & sustainability!

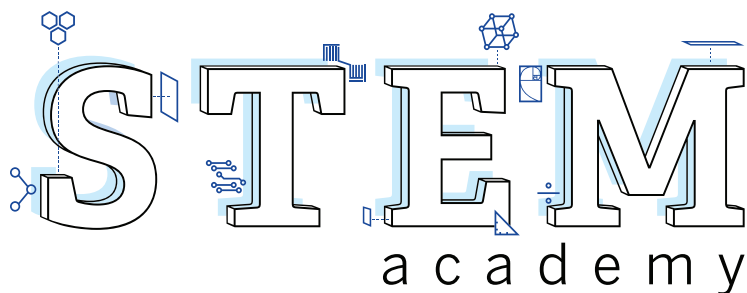
